So they left me and set off on their own. This made me really sad and do you know what, pretty soon it made people sad too. You see, without me, their lives just didn't work so well. People were arguing and fighting, bullying each other, people were getting hurt and ill and without me to pray to, there was no one to help.

The more I watched, the sadder I became, until I knew I had to do something to help people. I started by sending messengers, special people called prophets who told people how much I loved them.
